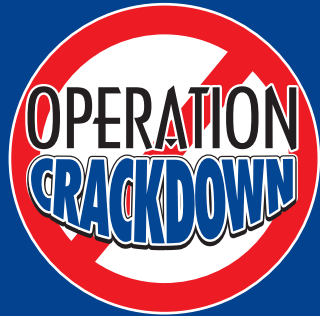




**Tired of wrecked and abandoned vehicles in your neighbourhood?**

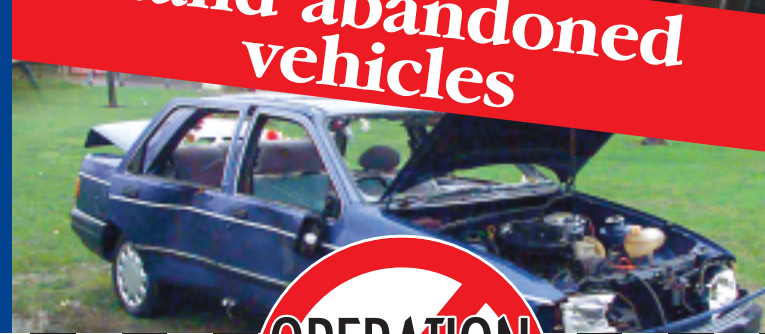

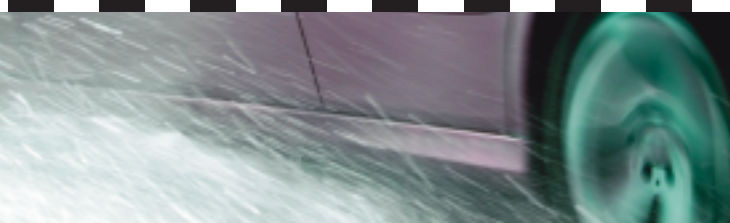

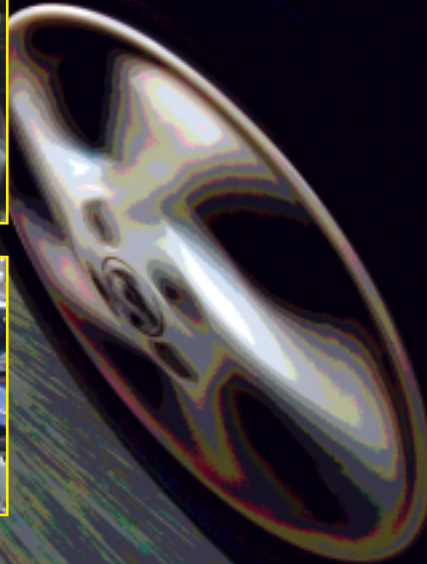

# Fed up with anti-social drivers?

## DON'T TOLERATE IT - REPORT IT!



We know there are problems in your part of Sussex - and we need your help to tackle them!

You can tell us about any abandoned vehicle or anti-social driving you've seen using the new Sussex-wide Operation Crackdown website.

*Speeding, thoughtless driving or riding, under-age drivers or riders, drink or drug driving, tailgating, mobile phone use, vehicles in unsafe condition, abandoned cars, untaxed cars and motorbikes...*

**Drivers and motorbike riders - don't do it - BEWARE - someone is watching you!**

**What to do if you see someone driving in an anti-social manner, or spot a suspected abandoned vehicle:**

- Pull over safely at the side of the road, or ask a passenger to write down details.
- Vehicle make, model, colour and number plate will all help police enquiries.



- When noting the location, use house numbers or shop names and road names to pinpoint where the incident happened or where you spotted a potential abandoned vehicle.

- Write a brief description of what you saw, while it is still fresh in your mind.

- When at work or home, visit [www.operationcrackdown.org](http://www.operationcrackdown.org) or call **01243 64 22 22** to record your information, which will only take a few minutes.

Your information will then be analysed and appropriate action taken if necessary by Sussex Police.
